NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES & OFFICE PAPER (JUNK MAIL): Mixed together - catalogs, telephone books, glossy inserts, paperback books, colored paper, white paper, wrapping paper, and junk mail. Any color or type of paper. **NO** brown Kraft bags and boxboard.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD, BROWN KRAFT BAGS & BOXBOARD: All boxboard, cardboard, brown bags mixed together. **NO** wax-coated cardboard, egg cartons, cardboard soiled with food waste, Styrofoam, strings, handles, or bags with plastic layers. Remove excess tape. Staples are OK.

TIN CANS: Separate from aluminum (tin is magnetic, aluminum is not). Please rinse. Labels OK. Crushing not required.

ALUMINUM CANS, FOIL AND FOOD TRAYS: Please rinse. Labels OK. Flattening not required. **Snack bags and candy wrappers are not aluminum foil!**

GLASS (ALL COLORS): Please rinse. All colors bottles and jars. Dishes, windows, mirror, ceramic, Pyrex and drinking glasses are acceptable. **NO** crystal, lids, metal or wood. **NO** light bulbs.

#1 through #4 PLASTIC CONTAINERS & #5 Food-Grade CONTAINERS: Please rinse. Labeled hard plastic containers, **2-gal capacity or less**, Please crush larger containers. **NO BLACK PLASTICS**, automotive oil containers, vinyl siding, Styrofoam, syringes or medical devices – These items should be regular household or bulky trash.

PLASTIC BAGS: Any plastic bag that is labeled #2, #4, or #5. Call for the current list of acceptable bags.

SPECIAL WASTES: 1# Propane Tanks, Aerosols, hard-covered books, tires (fees apply), electronic wastes, batteries, compact fluorescent bulbs, scrap metals, waste oil.

CLOTHING AND TEXTILES – Drop and Swaps are held in the spring and fall in Derby.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE– **BY APPOINTMENT ONLY**, Monday – Friday, May through the end of September in Lyndonville, and special events throughout the District June – September. Call for details.
