<p style="text-align: center;"><b>NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES &amp; OFFICE PAPER (JUNK MAIL)</b></p> <p>Mix together - catalogs, telephone books, glossy inserts and paperback books, colored paper, white paper, wrapping paper and junk mail. Any color or type of paper can be in this category except: <b>NO brown Kraft bags, boxboard, coffee cups, ice cream cartons, or metallic wrapping paper.</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD &amp; BROWN KRAFT BAGS &amp; BOXBOARD</b></p> <p>Remove excess tape. Staples are OK. Please no strings, handles, or bags with plastic layers. NO wax-coated cardboard, cardboard soiled with food waste, coffee cups, ice cream cartons, or Styrofoam.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>*BOXES MUST BE FLATTENED*</b></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>TIN CANS</b></p> <p>Labels are OK. Flattening not required. Separate from aluminum cans (A magnet will stick to tin but not to aluminum). <b>*MUST BE RINSED*</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>ALUMINUM CANS, FOIL AND FOOD TRAYS</b></p> <p>Labels OK. Flattening not required. Snack bags and candy wrappers are not aluminum foil.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>*MUST BE RINSED*</b></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>GLASS (ALL COLORS)</b></p> <p>Any color bottle or jar. Window glass, mirror, ceramic, Pyrex and drinking glasses also accepted. <b>NO crystal, lids, metal or wood. NO light bulbs.</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>*MUST BE RINSED*</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>*Remove lids – they generally go with tin*</b></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PLASTIC BAGS</b></p> <p>Must be labelled #2, #4, or #5. Any color accepted. Includes bubble wrap. <b>No Ziploc or nylon woven bags (like grain/cat litter bags)</b></p>

**PLASTIC CONTAINERS #1 – #4 & #5 Food Containers**

**2 Gallons or smaller / NO BLACK PLASTIC / \*MUST BE RINSED\***

Look for the recycling number stamped on the container. Labels are OK, please crush larger containers.

#5 accepted if it's a food container. **NO black plastic of any kind. NO automotive fluid bottles.**

**NO vinyl siding, toys, CD cases, VHS tapes, Styrofoam, syringes, or medical devices. These are trash.**

**ADDITIONAL MATERIALS ACCEPTED:**

**FOOD SCRAPS:** All food scraps, including meat, bones, dairy. Please remove PLU stickers. No plastics, metals, paper.

**HOUSEHOLD TRASH:** Trash disposal at transfer station provided by E-Z Trash Removal. Bags range from \$4.00-\$6.00, with additional costs for heavy/large materials. Residents can also contract with private haulers for curbside collection services, check out our list of Licensed Haulers on our website.

**SPECIAL WASTES:** Hard/Soft cover Books, Batteries, Cellular Phones, and Fluorescent Bulbs.

**CLOTHING AND TEXTILES** – H.O.P.E in Lyndonville accepts donations of lightly-used clothing.

**HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE:** BY APPOINTMENT ONLY, Monday – Friday, May through the end of September in Lyndonville, and special events throughout the District June – September. Call for details.
