



Topsham Recycling Guide

Topsham provides residents with single-stream recycling services.

NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES, JUNK MAIL, BOXBOARD, COARDBOARD: All paper products must be clean and free of food residues. Any color and type of paper. Please break down boxes. Staples OK, remove excess tape. No wax-coated boxes, soiled paper products (i.e., cheesy pizza boxes), soft or hard-covered books.

TIN CANS: Please rinse. Labels are OK. Flattening not required.

ALUMINUM CANS, FOILS: Please rinse. Wrap aluminum foil into ball larger than 2" before recycling. No snack bags, candy wrappers.

GLASS: Please rinse. Glass bottles and jars only, separate lids from containers. No crystal, Pyrex, ceramics, light bulbs, dishes, mirrors, windows.

PLASTIC CONTAINERS: #1-7 single-use containers accepted. Rinse clean. No durable plastics such as toys, housewares), plastic films and bags, caps under 2" in diameter. **NO black plastics accepted!**

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE: BY APPOINTMENT ONLY, Monday – Friday, May through the end of September at Lyndonville recycling center, and special events throughout the District June – September. Call for details.
